What causes a Stroke? Stroke is a cardiovascular disease that affects the vessels supplying blood to the brain. It is also called a brain attack. A stroke occurs when a blood vessel bringing oxygen and nutrients to the brain bursts or is clogged by a blood clot or some other particle. Because of the rupture or blockage, part of the brain does not get the flow of blood it needs. Deprived of oxygen, nerve cells in the affected area of the brain cannot function and die within minutes. And when nerve cells cannot function, the part of the body controlled by these cells cannot function either. There are four main types of stroke: two caused by blood clots and two by hemorrhage. Cerebral thrombosis and cerebral embolism, both caused by clots are by far the most common, accounting for about 70%-80% of all strokes. Cerebral and subarachnoid hemorrhages are caused by ruptured blood vessels and have a much higher fatality rate than stroke caused by clots.

Stroke Warning Signals:

Stroke is a medical emergency - call 9-1-1!

- Sudden numbness or weakness of the face, arm, or leg, especially on one side of the body.
 - Sudden confusion, trouble speaking or understanding.
 - Sudden trouble seeing in one or both eyes.
 - Sudden trouble walking, dizziness, loss of balance, or coordination.
 - Sudden, severe headache with no known causes.
